

CONSTITUTION OF THE U.F.A. PROVINCIAL POLITICAL ASSOCIATION

SECTION I.
The name of this association shall be "The U.F.A. Provincial Political Association."

SECTION II.
This Association shall consist of the officers and directors elected by the U.F.A. Provincial Association of Alberta.

SECTION III. OBJECTS.

(1) To constitute in itself a medium through which the various Federal and Provincial County/County District Organizations may act collectively where their common interests are concerned.

(2) To establish a bureau for the collecting and disseminating of statistics and other information bearing on the political welfare of the people.

(3) To assist the various Federal and Provincial Constituent Organizations in their efforts to bring groups of representatives having similar aims.

(4) To inspire and organize political organizations in the Federal and Provincial Courts/Judges of the Province.

(5) To promote the formation of a National Farmers' political organization.

SECTION IV. BOARD AND EXECUTIVE.

The Board of the Provincial Political Association shall consist of a President, six Executive Officers and eight directors. The President shall be nominated and elected by ballot from among the duly accredited delegates in open convention.

The Vice-President shall be elected by the Executive Committee from among their own number.

The delegates elected from each Federal Constituency shall determine the number to stand for election as Executive Officers and the four Executive Officers shall be elected by the Executive at large from the committee of names.

The four Executive Officers the highest number of votes shall be declared elected. The constituencies whose nominees have not been elected as Executive Officers shall each appoint one of their members to the Board. Three members of the Executive shall constitute a quorum and a majority of the Board shall constitute a quorum.

SECTION V. MEETINGS OF THE EXECUTIVE.
